Petitioner herein, *inter alia*, seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to transfer her to Sub Division Court at Ratia, District Fatehabad against an existing vacancy, as per exemption Clause 13 Para 7 of online Transfer Policy dated 15.11.2018 (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that qua her aforesaid grievance, petitioner submitted a representation dated 05.07.2021 (Annexure P-4), the same has not been adverted by the respondents till date. Hence, the instant petition.

3. On advance service, learned State counsel appears and submits that pending representation of the petitioner dated 05.07.2021 (Annexure P-4) shall be decided by the competent authority in due course in accordance with law.

4. Leaned counsel for the petitioner also agrees that let a final decision be taken, by the competent authority on the pending representation dated 05.07.2021 (Annexure P-4).

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to look into the grievance of the petitioner as per representation dated 05.07.2021 (Annexure P-4) and also by keeping in view the contentions raised in the present petition by treating the same as supplementary representation and take a decision, in accordance with law.

7. It is expected of the competent authority that the pending representation of the petitioner shall be considered in accordance with the applicable Transfer Policy qua couple cases working in the State. In case, petitioner is found entitled to any benefit thereof, subject, of course to the availability of the vacancy at any joint place of posting, petitioner shall be posted together with her husband.

8. Let the needful be done as expeditiously as possible.

9. Disposed of accordingly.
