The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for directing the official respondents No.2 and 3 to take action on the representation of the petitioners and for grant of protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

On a specific query being put to the learned counsel for the petitioners as to whether there is any real threat or apprehension of danger at the hands of the private respondents, the learned counsel for the petitioners has not been able to show even a single averment either in the petition or in the representation moved before the police authorities. The criminal writ petition is, therefore, vague and evasive and, therefore, no direction can be issued in this regard.

At this stage, the learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition in order to move an appropriate representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police concerned.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

It is made clear that in case in future the petitioners have any real threat or apprehension then they are always at liberty to move to the police authorities in accordance with law.
