Present petition has been filed with a prayer that a direction be issued to respondents No. 1 to 4 to restore/provide armed police protection to the petitioner as one of the family member of the petitioner namely Ankur Parjapati, who was the nephew of the petitioner, has been murdered on 19.01.2021 and the life and liberty of the petitioner is also under threat as none of the accused has been arrested so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already issued a legal notice for the said purpose to the Superintendent of Police, Sirsa on 26.08.2021, a copy of which has been attached with this petition as Annexure P-3 and the said legal notice is still under consideration with the said authority and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case, a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 26.08.2021 (Annexure P-3) by passing an

appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Gaurav Bansal, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection for deciding the legal notice of the petitioner in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 26.08.2021 (Annexure P-3), the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 26.08.2021 (Annexure P-3) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
