By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail, upon FIR No.130, dated 19.12.2019, having been registered at Police Station Ghuman, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 379 and 411 of the IPC.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Major Singh, submits that pursuant to the order dated 27.10.2020, the petitioner has joined investigation and presently his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, the petition has actually been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

However, if the petitioner's custodial interrogation is required at any stage hereinafter, in the context of the FIR in question, he would be given 7 days' notice before arrest, duly shown to be served upon him.

Naturally, if the complainant is aggrieved in any manner, of lack of proper investigation, he/she would be always at liberty to avail of his/her remedy as per law.
