HARI PAL VERMA, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

On the basis of complaints dated 24.09.2020 and 21.09.2020 submitted by Amandeep Kaur wife of Harjit Singh and Harmanbeer Singh son of Harjit Singh and the same being addressed to Hon'ble the Chief Justice of this Court, the complaints were treated as Criminal Writ Petition No.8734 of 2020 under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

In her complaint, complainant Amandeep Kaur has submitted that Gurbinder Singh son of Jaswinder Singh, resident of village Aima Khurd, District Tarn Taran is the real son of her Jeth and accused Balwinder Kaur wife of Amar Parkash, Prabhjot Kaur wife of Sandeep Singh, Ram Singh

Namdhariyan Sarpanch, Daljit Singh, Gurbir Singh, Harpal Singh, Manjinder Singh, Jagtar Singh Jagga etc. in connivance with each other have grievously injured Gurinder Singh etc. on 01.08.2020 with bullet shots. Thereafter, after 1 month on 01.09.2020 these accused have murdered Gurbinder Singh in fields, but no action was taken against the accused. Therefore, fair investigation be conducted in the case.

Since no one had put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners-complainants, vide order dated 25.01.2021, this Court had appointed Mr. Birinder Singh Khehar, Advocate as Legal Aid Counsel to assist the Court on behalf of the petitioners.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Sucha Singh, PPS, DSP, Sub Division Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran has been filed. The reply suggests that the sons of petitioner No.1 have committed the offence in connivance with other co-accused and the letters sent by the petitioner No.1 to this Court are nothing but an attempt to protect her sons. The petitioners have sent the representation to this Court in order to pressurize the local police, so that the police may not conduct the investigation pertaining the cases pending against them. Paragraph No.12 of the reply reads as under:

“12. That after completion of investigation pertaining to above said FIR No.331 dated 02.09.2020, pertaining to the son of the petitioner namely Jagjot Singh alias Bawa, the final report under section 173(2) of Cr.P.C. has already been presented in the learned Court of Illaqa Magistrate, Tarn Taran on 17.12.2020 and after completion of investigation pertaining to above said FIR No.305 dated 01.08.2020, pertaining to the son of the petitioner namely Jagjot Singh alias Bawa and petitioner No.2 namely Harmanbeer Singh, the final report under section 173(2)

of Cr.P.C. has already been presented in the learned Court of Illaqa Magistrate, Tarn Taran on 23.12.2020 and there is sufficient evidence against the accused i.e. petitioner No.2 and other son of the petitioner No.1 namely Jagjot Singh alias Bawa and they are likely to be convicted in the above said cases.”

In view of the reply submitted on behalf of the respondent-State, this Court does not find any substance in the present petition.

Accordingly, the present petition is hereby disposed of.
