The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this petition filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India is for issuance of direction to the respondent No.2 and 3, for protection of life and liberty of petitioners at the hands of private respondents i.e. 4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that earlier petitioner No.2 and respondent No.4 were married with each other, but now petitioner No. 2 after taking divorce from respondent No.4 has performed marriage with petitioner No.1.

Learned counsel appearing for respondents No.4 to 7 has disputed the very factum of divorce between respondent No.4 and petitioner No.2.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks withdrawal of this petition.
