Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the petitioners have an apprehension of threat to their life and liberty at the hands of respondent No.4, who is husband of petitioner No.1 and father of petitioner No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 and respondent No.4 have already taken divorce and are living separately but as father of respondent No.4 gave a certain piece of land to the petitioners, respondent No.4 is harrasing and threatening the petitioners to get the said land back and therefore, the petitioners apprehend that their life and liberty is at threat at the hands of respondent No. 4.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners have already filed a representation dated 14.09.2021 (Annexure P.4) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali, which is still

pending consideration with the said authority and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case, a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Singh Deol, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection for deciding the representation of the petitioners in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioners for the relief which has been claimed by them in the representation dated 14.09.2021 (Annexure P-4), the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 14.09.2021 (Annexure P-4) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
