Petitioner No.1 was earlier married but the decree of divorce has been granted.

Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have filed the present petition for protection.

Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-5) dated 16.9.2021 in this regard to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot and the SHO, Police Station Division No.2, District Pathankot.

Notice of motion to the office of Advocate General, Punjab.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Randhir Singh Thind, DAG, Punjab present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy supplied.

The petitioners have placed on record copies of Aadhar Cards of petitioner Nos.1 and 2 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) as proof of their age and copy of certificate (Annexure P-3) regarding performance of marriage and photographs (Annexure P-4).

This petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-SHO, Police Station Division No.2, District Pathankot, that representation, if any, filed seeking protection of life and liberty, be got looked into and contents thereof be duly verified and if necessary, requisite steps be taken, strictly in accordance with law for grant of protection of life and liberty to the petitioners. It is made clear that this order shall not be treated as a stamp of this Court regarding validity of marriage of the parties.
