1. This petition in the nature of habeas corpus was filed seeking release of detainee-Mamta. As per the pleadings there was apprehension that respondent No.4-Mohit Kumar has allured the detainee from a religious place.

2. Notice of motion was issued on 20th September, 2021.

3. Reply dated 6th October, 2021 filed by learned State counsel is taken on record. Copy of the same supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner. With the reply statement of detainee is annexed.

4. As per the statement and the pleadings in the reply, the detainee has solemnized marriage with respondent No.4-Mohit Kumar and is living with him on her own sweet will.

- 5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent No.4 is not of marriageable age, the marriage is voidable.
- 6. Considering the fact that there is no illegal detention of the detenue, no further directions are called for.

- 8. Needless to say that the petitioner is at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law for redressal of surviving grievances, if any.
