The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.228 dated 26.08.2020 registered under Sections 452, 379-B, 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added lateron) at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the orders dated 29.10.2020 and 01.12.2020 passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhjit Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioners is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners No.2 and 3 vide order dated 29.10.2020 and to petitioner No.1 vide dated 01.12.2020 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
