1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for intentional and willful defiance of order dated 09.07.2021 in CWP No. 12226 of 2021.

3. Learned counsel contends that pursuant to filing of the instant petition the respondent has passed order dated 16.09.2021 deciding the claim made in the Notice of Demand dated 12.02.2021, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 16.09.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

3. In view of the position as noted above, statement of learned counsel for the petitioner as well the fact that notice has yet not been issued in the petition, no action under the Contempt of Courts, 1971 is called for against the respondent.

4. Accordingly, contempt petition is disposed of as such while

granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 16.09.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
