The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioners have come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release the pension of the petitioners within the time bound schedule alongwith interest @ 12% per annum, for which, representation dated 07.07.2021 (Annexure P-1) has also been submitted before the respondent authorities.

At the asking of the Court Mr. Shireesh Gupta, Sr. DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 and 2. Let copy of the paper book be supplied to him.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioners' side, the directions are issued to the respondent authorities to duly consider the representation dated 07.07.2021 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioners and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioners are held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to them without any delay as per law.
