Learned counsel for the petitioners has informed the Court that till date, there is no eviction order passed against the petitioners.

In the light of the above, despite the fact that an order in a petition under Section 13-A of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961, rejecting the claim of the petitioners for being declared as the owners of the land has been passed and in the absence of any eviction order, the question of their dispossession does not arise and the apprehension of the petitioners is totally misplaced.

The writ petition, therefore, stands dismissed as there is no eviction order against the petitioners till date, as per the statement of counsel for the petitioners.
