Instant writ petition has been filed assailing an order dated 29.05.2018 (Annexure P-4) vide which a site i.e. SCF-64 at Mandi Fatehgarh Churian has been resumed.

Suffice it to take note that the site in question had been allotted to the petitioner in the year 2011 in an open auction conducted by the Punjab State Agricultural Marketing Board.

Apparently, the petitioner failed to deposit the installment as per the schedule indicated in the allotment letter. After due opportunity having been granted, the Estate Officer concerned as a matter of last resort has passed the resumption order.

Counsel having argued the matter at length and confronted with a situation where this Court was not inclined to intervene seeks withdrawal of the writ petition so as to avail of the alternate remedy of appeal, if any, against the order of resumption.

As per submission made by counsel, petition is disposed of as not pressed with liberty as prayed for.

It is clarified that in the eventuality of the petitioner preferring an appeal, the liberty that is being granted would not be construed as an expression of our opinion as regards the maintainability of the same as also as regards condoning the delay that may have occurred.
