By this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR no.10 dated 12.01.2019, registered at Police Station City, Majri, District SAS Nagar (Mohali), for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 323/379-B/201 and 34 of the IPC, as also all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

The petition having been filed more than 2 years and 8 months after the FIR had been registered, even though learned counsel has pointed out that the FIR had been registered simply one day after the order dated 11.01.2019 had been passed by the Director, Village Development and Panchayat Department, Punjab, directing that action be taken for eviction of the complainant in FIR (respondent No.2), from shamlat land, at this stage, when even charges have been framed, 2 years and 8 months later, I would find no ground to entertain this petition, which is consequently dismissed at the threshold, with no comment made on the merits of the case, which would be considered by the trial court as per the evidence led before it.

Learned counsel for the petitioner however submits that the petitioner would avail appropriate proceedings for challenging the order

framing the charges. Obviously that liberty will always be available to him,
with any such petition filed to be considered on its own merits.
