**SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)**

The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing official respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, which is under imminent danger, at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6. Another prayer has been made for directing respondents No.2 and 3 to take action on the representation dated 16.09.2021, Annexure P-3, submitted by the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is owner of a mini bus, who runs a bus service in the name of New Khatra and has been issued a five year permit by the Regional Transport Authority (RTA), Ludhiana. Counsel further submits that the private respondents No.4 to 6,

who are big bus operators, do not permit the petitioner to run his bus service on the scheduled time table and have been extending threats to him. Counsel submits that the petitioner has submitted representations to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna-respondent No.2, but they have not been attended to. He submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to look into his representation.

Request of the counsel has been considered.

Without examining the allegations made in the petition or in the representation, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna, respondent No.2 to examine the representation dated 16.09.2021, Annexure P-3, submitted by the petitioner and thereafter to take suitable steps as warranted in accordance with law.

A copy of this order along with the representation dated 16.09.2021, Annexure P-3, be communicated to respondent No.2 in order to enable him to do the needful within a period of four weeks from the date of the receipt of the same.
