By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'pre-arrest bail' upon FIR No. 174 having been registered at Police Station City-1, Abohar, District Fazilka, on 26.08.2021, alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under the provisions of Section 21 of the NDPS Act, 1985 (with Sections 27/29 of that Act having been added later).

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Mirkhi Ram, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation pursuant to the order dated 20.09.2021 and presently his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, the petition has actually been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

However, if the petitioners' custodial interrogation is required at any stage hereinafter, in the context of the FIR in question, he would be given 7 days notice before arrest, duly shown to be served upon him.
