The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 248 dated 22.05.2018, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, besides Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, registered at Police Station Baldev Nagar, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had been arrested and granted regular bail. He, however, could not appear before the Court only on one date due to Covid-19 pandemic and consequently his bail was cancelled. He undertakes that the petitioner shall henceforth appear before the Court on each and every date of hearing and would not absent himself except with prior permission of the Court.

This Court, by the order dated 21.09.2021 had directed the petitioner to appear before the trial Court and on his doing so, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty

Magistrate.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in terms of the orders of this Court, the petitioner had appeared before the trial Court on 30.11.2021 and has been granted interim bail.

In view of the above and the petitioner having appeared before the trial Court, the order dated 21.09.2021 granting interim bail to petitioner is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of.

However, the petitioner shall henceforth appear before the Court on each and every date of hearing and would not absent himself except with prior permission of the Court.
