Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 444 dated 24.07.2020, under Sections 323, 34, 498-A of IPC (Section 377 of IPC of 1860 was deleted later on), registered at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa.

By virtue of the order dated 28.10.2020, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that the recovery part is yet to be made.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Vishal has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further

investigation.

In view of the same, the interim order dated 28.10.2020 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
