By the instant civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India the petitioner Surinder Parkash Singh Dhindsa seeks to challenge the order dated 24.08.2021 (Annexure P-26) passed by the respondents. The Punjab Heritage and Tourism Promotion Board which is a public charitable trust of the Government of Punjab got outsourced its services from M/s Ascenture Management Services Private Limited. The outsourcing company engaged the services of the petitioner on the post of Project Coordinator (Admin.) but on account of renunciation of duties by the petitioner, the outsourcing agency dispensed with the services and which is the subject matter of the present challenge.

Heard counsel for the petitioner.

The petitioner was engaged by the outsourcing agency M/s Ascenture Management Services Private Limited and admittedly as per the own stand of the petitioner, he was never engaged by the respondents and, therefore, there does not exists any relationship of employer and employee between the two. More so, it is outsourcing company which has dispensed with the services of the petitioner who have not been arraigned as a party to the present petition together with the fact that engagement of the petitioner by the outsourcing agency at no point of time binds the State-the respondents and the present petition being hopelessly without any merits stands dismissed in *limine*.
