The present second petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.229 dated 11.12.2018 registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station City-2 Khanna, District Ludhiana.

At the outset, the counsel for the State has submitted that the prosecution have completed their evidence in the case. Now, the case is fixed for defense evidence, if the petitioner intends to take the one. If there is any delay in the trial any more that will not be on the part of the prosecution.
