Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No.1 & 2 to remove anomaly in pay between senior and junior employees which has occurred due to implementation of 4-year Assured Career Progression in the pay scales revised in the year 2011 (P-5).

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for the petitioners, on instructions, states that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied in case legal notice dated 04.02.2021 (P-7) is considered and decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, who is present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 and 2 and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to

respondent No.2 to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice (P-7) in accordance with law by passing speaking order within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
