The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to promote the petitioner to the post of Superintendent Grade-I w.e.f. 07.10.2011, the date on which his juniors were promoted as such vide orders dated 07.10.2011 (Annexure P-2), grant proficiency step up w.e.f. 07.10.2015 and revise his pay and the pensionary benefits and also to make payment of arrears with interest at the rate of 12% p.a.; and to decide the legal notice dated 27.02.2021 (Annexure P-6).
