This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 219 dated 12.05.2021, registered under Section 7 of Essential Commodities Act, 1955, Sections 27(b)(ii), 28 of Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940, Section 51(b) Disaster Management Act, 2005 and Sections 420 & 34 of IPC, 1860 at Police Station Hisar City, District Hisar, Haryana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the three co-accused of the petitioner who are identically situated have been granted the concession of regular bail by this Hon'ble Court and the orders are attached herewith as Annexures P-3 and P-4. He has further sent the order granting bail to co-accused Siya Ram in the WhatsApp group.

In view of the fact that three of the co-accused of the petitioner have been granted the concession of regular bail, and the State having fairly conceded that the case of the petitioner is similar to that of the accused who have been granted bail, the further incarceration of the petitioner is not required.

Therefore, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate, concerned.
