This appeal has been filed against a judgment of learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition filed by the petitioner, wherein he had taken the plea that his application for voluntary retirement was in fact not voluntary and he had been coerced to quit and the ground taken was that it was written by somebody else.

Learned Single Judge dismissed the writ petition holding that once the signatures of the petitioner were not disputed, no further action could be taken in the matter.

We are also of the considered opinion that these are pure questions of fact, which could not be adjudicated in writ jurisdiction. The appeal, therefore, is accordingly dismissed leaving the appellant to take whatever remedy he may have in accordance with law.

Since the main case has been dismissed, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
