This is a petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions for transfer of investigation of FIR No.188 dated 08.08.2020 under Section 420 read with Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014, registered at Police Station Lohian, District Jalandhar (Rural) (Annexure P-1), which is pending with respondent No.4.

After arguing for some time and faced with the dictum of law laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case titled **Sakiri Vasu Vs. State of U.P. and others**, reported as **2008 (2) SCC 409** and in **M. Subramaniam and another Vs. S. Janaki and another, Criminal Appeal No.102 of 2011**, decided on 20.03.2020, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that the present petition be disposed of with liberty to pursue alternative remedies, in accordance with law.
