Case heard via video conferencing.

By this petition, the petitioners seek quashing, on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the petitioners and respondent no. 2, of FIR no. 195, dated 06.12.2018, registered at Police Station City Kotkapura, District Faridkot, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 420/120 of the IPC, as also all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom. A copy of the compromise deed has been annexed as Annexure P-2 with the petition.

A short affidavit dated 28.11.2020 has been filed by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Police, Kotkapura, which is ordered to be taken on record.

As per the said affidavit there is no other criminal case of like nature registered against the four petitioners in this petition, with it also stated that they are not required for any further investigation.

Pursuant to the order dated 30.10.2020, a report of the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Faridkot, dated 27.11.2020, has been received, stating that the petitioners as also respondent no. 2, i.e. the complainant in the FIR, appeared before that court, with the complainant, Gurwinder Kaur, having recorded her statement to the effect that the four petitioners are herein are the only persons involved in the matter and that a compromise has been effected between her and the petitioners of her their own free will, with the petitioners also having recorded a statement before that court as regards the compromise reached between the parties.

The investigating officer also suffered a statement to the effect that there is no other person involved in the occurrence other than the petitioners and that there is no other criminal case pending against any of them.

That being so, with learned counsel appearing for respondent no. 2 also submits that the compromise arrived at between the parties subsists, the petition is allowed and FIR no. 195, dated 06.12.2018, registered at Police Station City Kotkapura, District Faridkot, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 420/120 of the IPC, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
