The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID-19.

Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.0150 dated 11.12.2019 under Sections 323, 324 and 34 IPC and Section 325 IPC added later on, registered at Police Station Mohkampura, Amritsar and all other consequential proceedings arising out of the said FIR, as the matter stands amicably settled in terms of compromise deed dated 03.03.2020.

Vide order dated 29.10.2020, the parties were directed to appear before the CJM/Illaq Magistrate/Trial Court on 23.11.2020 for getting their statements recorded with regard to the compromise.

A report dated 03.12.2020 of learned JMIC, Amritsar, has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned JMIC, Amritsar and got recorded their statements regarding compromise. Learned Magistrate has stated that he is of the considered view that the compromise between the parties is valid, genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

In view thereof, the present petition is allowed. FIR No.0150 dated 11.12.2019 under Sections 323, 324 and 34 IPC and Section 325 IPC added later on, registered at Police Station Mohkampura, Amritsar, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
