Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner very fairly states that the present writ petition qua the continuance in the office of Sarpanch, has been rendered infructuous keeping in view the fact that the

State has issued order dated 12.02.2021 taking charge from all the

Sarpanches. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the question whether any recovery can be done from the petitioner or not, be left open as and when, the said action, if taken against the petitioner so that the petitioner can avail appropriate remedy at the said stage.

The present writ petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous keeping in view the continuance of the petitioner as Sarpanch in view of the order dated 12.02.2021 issued by the Government of Haryana and the question whether any recovery can be done from the petitioner in respect of any action taken by her during her tenure is kept open and in case, the petitioner is aggrieved against any action of the State, she will be at liberty to avail appropriate remedy for the redressal of the said grievance by taking all possible objections.

As the main case has been disposed of having been rendered infructuous, applications i.e. CM-2219-CWP-2021 and CM-12274-CWP-2020 also stand infructuous.
