Prayer in the present Criminal Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of an appropriate order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the main grouse of the petitioner is that when he goes to attend the case proceedings in Amritsar, with respect to the proceeding initiated by his wife under Section 125 of Cr.P.C., there is a chance of him being falsely implicated in different cases. He has further submitted that he has already moved a transfer petition in this High Court and the same is pending adjudication and thus, he wishes to withdraw the present Criminal Writ Petition with liberty to take all the points as raised in the present petition in the abovesaid transfer petition.
