Heard through video conferencing.

The petitioners are seeking a direction to the official respondents to protect their life and liberty, as they apprehend danger from respondents No. 4 to 9.

It is stated in the petition that petitioners have performed their marriage, which is against the will of private respondents and they have apprehension that the private respondents might cause physical harm to them.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has drawn my attention to the representation dated 18.09.2021 (Annexure P-5) sent by the petitioners to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur (respondent No. 2).

Issue notice to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Dhruv Dayal, Senior DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3.

Mr. Sukhjit Singh, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of

respondents No. 4 to 9. He contends that respondents No. 4 and 5 are the parents of petitioner No. 1 and they have 'no objection' to the marriage. They may be permitted to meet the petitioners.

Keeping in view the mandate of the Supreme Court in the case of Lata Singh vs. State of U.P. and another, JT 2006 (6) SC 173, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur (respondent No. 2) to look into the matter and take appropriate action in accordance with law to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of the private respondents.

The Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur (respondent No. 2) shall also arrange a meeting between the petitioners and respondents No. 4 and 5 at any convenient place with adequate protection.

It is clarified that this order shall not be treated as a stamp of this Court about the marriage of the parties and no opinion with regard to the validity of the marriage has been expressed in this order.
