Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents to issue GPF numbers to petitioners and treat them as members of old pension scheme which was in existence prior to 01.01.2004.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for the petitioners, on instructions, states that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied in case representation dated 23.07.2021 (P-11) is considered and decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, who is present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to

respondent No.3 to consider and decide the aforesaid representation (P-11) in accordance with law by passing speaking order within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
