The petitioners have invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to issue GPF numbers to the petitioners and treat them as members of old pension scheme which was in existence prior to 01.01.2004 and release all their pension and other retiral benefits along with interest @ 12% p.a.; and to decide their representation dated 23.07.2021 (Annexure P-10).

Mr. Ayush Sarna, Asst. Advocate General, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents. Copy of the paper book has been supplied to him.
