This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.186 dated 18.11.2020, under Sections 363, 366-A, 120-B, 376 IPC and Section 4 of POCSO Act registered at Police Station City South Moga, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein would contend that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the said matter and is in custody since 23.08.2019. It is further submitted that the prosecutrix has turned hostile.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State does not oppose the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

I have heard counsel for the parties and have also perused case file.

In view of the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 23.08.2019; trial will take time and the prosecutrix has turned hostile, I deem it appropriate to allow the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner. The petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
