Present application has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for preponing the date of hearing of the main case i.e. CRM-M-31195-2019.

Mr. R.S.Khaira, AAG, Punjab and Mr. B.S.Dhindsa, Advocate accept notice on behalf of respondent No. 1 and respondents No. 2 to 4 respectively. They have no objection in case the matter is preponed.

For the reasons enumerated in the application, the same is allowed and the main case is preponed and taken up today itself for hearing.

Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 52 dated 03.05.2019 under Sections 326/324/323/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Dayalpura, District Bathinda, and all other consequential proceedings arising out of the said FIR, as the matter stands amicably settled in terms of compromise.

Vide order dated 23.07.2019, the parties were directed to appear before the concerned Illaqa/Duty Magistrate on 18.09.2019 for getting their statements recorded with regard to the compromise and the trial Court was to send its report regarding the genuineness of compromise.

A report dated 05.10.2019 of learned JMIC, Phul, has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned JMIC, Phul and got recorded their statements regarding compromise. Learned Magistrate has stated that he is of the considered view that the compromise between the parties is valid, genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

In view thereof, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 52 dated 03.05.2019 under Sections 326/324/323/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Dayalpura, District Bathinda, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
