Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.27 dated 25.01.2020, under Sections 147, 148, 149, 302, 452, 325, 506 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station IMT, Rohtak.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the deceased Ram Chander had suffered one injury on his head which was an outcome of a dispute with regard to the boundary wall. The petitioner is alleged to have caught hold of the deceased. She is 39 years old lady having two minor children. She is in custody for over 01 ½ years and not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Rajesh states that the challan has been filed but charges are yet to be framed. He further contends that in view of the serious allegation against the petitioner, she is not entitled to the concession of regular bail.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner, who is 39 years old lady, is in custody for over 01 ½ years, she allegedly caught hold of

the deceased, she is having two minor children, Covid 19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
