GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J.

Petitioner-Kusum Rani, stated to be aged 32 years, has filed present petition *inter alia* with a prayer to direct the appellate Court to decide the appeal against the order dated 15.06.2020 (Annexure P-5).

Records of the case show that this Court on 02.11.2020 passed the following order:-

Learned counsel for the petitioner has made reference to various zimni orders dated 22.07.2020, 30.07.2020, 23.09.2020 and 07.10.2020, passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Chandigarh. He submits that after 07.10.2020, further urgency has arisen and therefore this has necessitated the filing of present

petition seeking directions that the Appellate Court be directed to take up the appeal and decide the interim prayer immediately.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Palika Monga, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent No.3.

Notice to other respondents be served through dasti process as well, returnable for 22.01.2021.

In the peculiar facts as noticed above, the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Chandigarh, is directed to take up the appeal and application for interim stay on 04.11.2020 and decide the issue of interim relief on the same day or by taking up the matter if so requires on day to day basis.”

Today on the resume hearing of the case, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has instructions from his client to inform the Court that the appeal has already been decided on 06.11.2020 and therefore, no further order is called for.

In view of the above, revision petition is disposed of.
