Present petition has been filed with a prayer that a direction be issued to the respondents to transfer the Complaint No.287/S/SSP to be enquired into by the Crime Branch of the State Police or by a Special Investigation Team.

At the time of hearing of the petition, learned counsel for the petitioners very fairly submits that he is not pressing the said prayer but as his complaints are not being taken to logical end, he had filed a representation to respondent No.2 on 08.03.2021 (Annexure P-2) for deciding the complaint expeditiously.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that even the said representation did not bear any fruit and he had to file a reminder with respondent No.2 on 11.08.2021, copy of which has been appended with this

petition as Annexure P-3. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners will be satisfied at this stage, in case, a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 08.03.2021 (Annexure P-2) and reminder dated 11.08.2021 (Annexure P-3) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Kumar, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection for deciding the representation dated 08.03.2021 (Annexure P-2) and reminder dated 11.08.2021 (Annexure P-3) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by them in the representation dated 08.03.2021 (Annexure P-2) and reminder dated 11.08.2021 (Annexure P-3), the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 08.03.2021 (Annexure P-2) and reminder dated 11.08.2021 (Annexure P-3) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
