The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.154 dated 10.09.2020, under Sections 307, 323, 353, 186, 341, 427, 148, 149, 506, 325, 295, 332 & 333 IPC, registered at Police Station Koom Kalan, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends it is alleged that the accused had attacked the police party. He, however, contends that no injury is attributed to the petitioner. He further contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other case. The similarly situated co-accused namely Gurpreet Singh and the co-accused Pooja Rani have been granted anticipatory bail by the coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-34792 of 2020 on 29.10.2020.

This Court, by the order dated 13.01.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the

satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Hazoori Lal, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 13.01.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
