Case taken up through video conferencing.

On 23.09.2021, a Coordinate Bench of this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that initially the FIR was registered for the offences under Sections 323, 324, 34, 506 IPC and the petitioner was granted bail. Offence under Sections 325 and 326 IPC were added later on on 18.07.2021 and for the enhanced culpability the petitioner is sought to be arrested on 18.07.2021.

Notice of motion for 21.12.2021.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 29.09.2021 at 11.00 A.M., and in the

event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on interim bail, subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Nothing expressed hereinabove shall be construed to be an opinion on the merits of the case. The case shall be decided on merits on the adjourned date.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Jaipal Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 23.9.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
