The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No. 82, dated 28.09.2020, under Sections 34, 354-B, 376 (2)(n), 377, 406, 498-A, 506 IPC (Section 313 IPC added later on), registered at Women Police Station, District Sonipat.

Pursuant to order dated 10th November, 2020, status report by way of affidavit of Nikita Khattar, IPS, Assistant Superintendent of Police, Sonipat, on behalf of the respondent State, has been filed. Same is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions. As per the status report, offences under Sections 376 & 313 IPC stand deleted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 10th November, 2020, passed by this Court, the petitioners have been released on interim bail.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the aforesaid fact.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the prayer and submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and submitted that

recovery of some dowry articles is yet to be effected.

The allegations with regard to the give and take of dowry articles and cash are disputed questions of fact, which would be looked into when the evidence is adduced before the trial court.

In view of the above, the instant petition is allowed and interim order dated 10th November, 2020, vide which the petitioners were granted interim bail by the coordinate Bench of this Court, is made absolute.
