Instant writ petition has been filed seeking a writ of mandamus for directing first respondent i.e. Principal Secretary, Town and Country Planning Department, New Secretariat, Sector-17, Chandigarh to hear and dispose of Appeal No.8 of 2020 (Annexure P-6) preferred by the petitioner against memo dated 25.06.2020 issued by the District Town Planner, rejecting the request as regards change of land use and for setting up an industrial unit in the Revenue Estate of Village Dhaturi, District Sonapat.
