1. This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents No. 2 and 5 to take physical possession of the mortgaged property and handover the same to the petitioner bank in compliance of the orders dated 28.3.2019 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.2 under Section 14 of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the amount has been paid and the account is settled, therefore this petition may be dismissed as infructuous.

3. In view of the above statement, the present petition stands dismissed as infructuous. Ordered accordingly.
4. Since the main case has been dismissed as infructuous, the pending application, if any, also stands dismissed as infructuous.
