Case taken up through video conferencing.

Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.467 dated 25.08.2020 registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 342, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station Azad Nagar, Hisar District Hisar, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case; there is no other criminal case pending against him; even if the contents of the FIR are taken as the gospel truth, though vehemently denied, no injury is attributed to the petitioner; co-accused Udaybeer Singh and Jitender Kumar have been granted anticipatory bail by the Trial Court and that under the interim orders passed by this Court the petitioner has not only joined the investigation but has also fully cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel submits that under the interim orders passed by this Court the petitioner has not only joined the investigation but has also fully co-operated with the investigating agency and that his custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

After considering the above noticed facts especially the statement made by the learned State counsel that the petitioner has joined the investigation and that his custodial interrogation is not required, the

order of this Court dated 30.10.2020, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

Nothing observed herein-above shall be considered to be an expression of opinion by this Court on the merits of the case.
