The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Articles 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members from the hands of respondents No.4 and 5. Another prayer has been made for directing respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 25.08.2021, Annexure P-2, submitted by the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is the owner and in possession of property bearing House No.75 situated at Basti Peer Daad Khan, Tara Singh Avenue, Raja Garden, Tehsil and District Jalandhar for the last more than fifteen years. Respondents No.4 and 5, who are working as press correspondents and running online web portal, tried to

dispossess the petitioner and his family members from the property, who have filed a Civil Suit and by order dated 09.07.2021, Annexure P-3, the trial Court has directed the parties to maintain status quo qua possession till further orders. He submits that the said private respondents have been pressurizing the petitioner to vacate their house and have been threatening that they will get the petitioner and his family members implicated in false criminal cases. Counsel submits that petitioner has submitted a representation, Annexure P-2, to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, respondent No.2, which is not being attended to. Counsel urges that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned respondent to look into the representation, Annexure P-2.

Request of the counsel has been considered.

Without commenting upon the allegations levelled in the petition or in the representation, Annexure P-2, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, respondent No.2, to examine the representation, Annexure P-2, submitted by the petitioner and to take appropriate steps thereafter as warranted in accordance with law.

A copy of this order as well as that of the representation, Annexure P-2, be sent to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, respondent No.2, to do the needful within a period of two months from the date of the receipt of the copy of this order.
