Respondents No.3-Reliance General Insurance Co. Ltd. &
respondent No.7-The New India Insurance Co. Ltd. have offered to pay
an amount of Rs.1,30,000/- (Rupees One Lakh and Thirty Thousand
Only) in 50:50 ratio, as has been directed by the Tribunal, towards
compensation over and above the amount already awarded by the
Tribunal in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal.

The aforesaid offer is acceptable to the claimant/appellant.

Accordingly, the instant appeal is disposed of with a
direction to respondents No.3-Reliance General Insurance Co. Ltd. &
respondent No.7-The New India Insurance Co. Ltd. to deposit their
separate crossed-cheque/s (in 50:50 ratio) total amounting to
Rs.1,30,000/- in the name of appellant with the office of the Lok Adalat

of this High Court within a period of 45 days, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned official of the Lok Adalat shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the Insurance Company. The appellant's counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
