This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the representation dated 22.02.2018 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner for grant of promotional benefits from the date of promotion granted to his juniors Nar Singh, Dharam Singh by counting seniority of the petitioner and for grant of benefits of computation of pension in the light of order dated 24.10.2016 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.3 and information dated 23.08.2021 (Annexure P-7) received by the petitioner under the RTI Act. It is further prayed that the respondents be directed to consider the case of the petitioner and take the final decision on the representation of the petitioner dated 22.02.2018 (Annexure P-3) by passing a well reasoned speaking order within a time bound frame.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that, at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondents take a conscious decision on the representation of the petitioner dated 22.02.2018 (Annexure P-3) and pass a speaking order thereon, within a time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rajesh Gaur, Addl. Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Even counsel for the respondents is not averse to the expeditious disposal of the claim of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioner dated 22.02.2018 (Annexure P-3) and take a conscious decision thereon by passing a speaking order; within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that if the petitioner is found entitled to any pecuniary benefits upon such a conscious decision; then the said pecuniary benefits shall also be released to the petitioner within a further period of three months; from the date of such conscious decision of the authorities.
