Case heard by way of video conferencing.

On 26.11.2020, the following order had been passed:-

“All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail' under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., upon FIR no.262, dated 15.06.2020, having been registered at Police Station Farakpur, District Yamuna Nagar, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 343, 354-C, 376(2)(n) and 506 of the IPC.

Both, learned counsel for the petitioner as also the complainant - prosecutrix (respondent no.2), are ad idem that the matter has been compromised between the parties and the petitioner has agreed to marry respondent no.2.

Learned State counsel submits, on query, that as per the FIR the prosecutrix is 20 years old, with the age of the petitioner given to be 25 years.

That being so, the petitioner is ordered to be admitted to interim

bail to the satisfaction of the trial court/CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned, till the next date of hearing before this court.

A report shall be filed by a gazetted officer by that date as to whether the terms of the compromise have been honoured or not.

Adjourned to 28.01.2021.”

With the turn of the case not having come up on 28.01.2021, today learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurmeet Singh, as also counsel for the complainant, both submit that the matter has been resolved between the parties, with the petitioner having married the complainant.

That being so, the present petition is allowed, with the order dated 26.11.2020, granting interim bail to the petitioner, made absolute.
