Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, is for quashing the action of the respondents in not granting the petitioners benefit of pay scale equivalent to the pay scales granted to the Agriculture Development Officers.

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioners, states that at this stage, instead of pressing the petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied, in case, representations dated 26.07.2021 (P-10), 05.08.2021 (P-11 & P-12) are decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without

going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2, to consider and decide the aforesaid representations dated 26.07.2021 (P-10), 05.08.2021 (P-11 & P-12), in accordance with law by passing speaking order(s), within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, respondent No.2 is not the competent authority, the same be forwarded to the concerned quarter within one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
