The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.63 dated 02.06.2020 under Sections 323, 324, 427, 148, 149 and 188 IPC (Sections 452, 326, 307 and 120-B IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Sadar Banga, District S.B.S. Nagar.

Vide previous order dated 23.12.2020, the petitioner was admitted on interim bail to attend his ailing father, subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that though the father of petitioner is still admitted in the hospital, but the petitioner undertakes to surrender before the jail authorities within a week.

Since the petitioner was admitted on interim bail solely for the reason to attend his ailing father, who was admitted in the hospital and the petitioner has undertaken to surrender before the jail authorities within a week, the present petition is hereby dismissed with a direction that the petitioner shall surrender before the jail authorities on or before 25.01.2021.
